
Avg. worship attendance, May – August: 52 (note increasing numbers for the past four months in comparison with previous years)

Supply chain issues are becoming hard to just replace them as they fail. The time it takes to get them could leave us without a working furnace or ac for guite some time.

We completed the first phase of the parking lot and will continue to raise funds for the next phase. If you want any information about the next phase, please let us know.

We will be repairing the elevator roof scupper and repainting the wood windows on the upper floors along with all the facia wood. This requires a boom lift rental and delivery for one week.
