

What does God's Word say about the present conflict in Israel?

Some Christians try to interpret the biblical promises of God to Israel as applying to the presentday State of Israel, a political entity established in 1948. This contradicts at least two important words of Jesus: "My kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36) and "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority" (Acts 1:7). This misleading and incorrect interpretation of Scripture also ignores the fact that "Israel" or "the Jews" sometimes refers to those who are biologically descended from the Patriarchs (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob) and sometimes refers to those who "share the faith of Abraham" (Romans 4:16) regardless of whether they are physically descendants of the Patriarchs ("Jews") or come from other ancestors ("Gentiles"). The true Israel of God consists of all those who are a new creation by the work of the Holy Spirit through the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ (Galatians 6:14-16).



We rejoice in the gifts and promises of God which He gave to Abraham and his descendants (see Romans 3:1-2 and Romans 9:1-5). Read Romans 9-11 to understand what love and respect and honor and humility we should have toward the Jews as descendants of Abraham. With amazing grace God has continued to bless the Jewish people in many ways, including by allowing the formation of the State of Israel, and He continues to call ALL people, Jews, Gentiles, Israelis, Palestinians, even Americans, to "be reconciled to God" (2nd Corinthians 5:16-21) through faith in Jesus Christ, the Savior of all. We pray for an end to war and conflict. We pray for peace on earth and that all may know the true peace and reconciliation with God and with one another that has been accomplished by Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:14-18).

We pray: O God, from whom come all holy desires, all good counsels, and all just works, give to us, Your servants, that peace which the world cannot give, that our hearts may be set to obey Your commandments and also that we, being defended from the fear of our enemies, may live in peace and quietness; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
